



Call for volunteers for European youth camps in Ukraine

House of Europe is looking for volunteers from EU countries to take part in youth camps with Ukrainian children aged 11-13 or 14-16 years old. The first camp will take place in May 2020 (duration: 2 weeks). 4 other camps will take place in July-August 2020. Each volunteer will participate in two camps during the summer in two different locations (2 camps x 2 weeks each = 4 weeks). The camps will focus on the following values: tolerance & inclusion or ecology & sustainable development.

The main tasks for volunteers

- Fostering the values promoted by the EU among Ukrainian teenagers
- Promoting mutual understanding and exchanges between Ukrainian and European cultures
- Developing and supporting youth initiatives
- Participating in activities according to programme methodology

Plane tickets, meals and accommodation (single rooms) will be provided. A Skype briefing will be organised before arriving in Ukraine, and a training will be conducted in Kyiv before the camps with the project team. The volunteers will be supervised, tutored and trained by the team of animators. After the camp, the volunteer will receive a participation certificate.

About House of Europe

House of Europe is a new programme funded by the European Union for professional and creative exchanges between Ukraine and the EU in the fields of Cultural and Creative Industries, education, healthcare, media, social entrepreneurship and youth work. The main task of the House of Europe is to promote international mobility, exchange of experience and cooperation in EU countries among professionals from Ukraine. In particular, the programme enables attending events for professional development and creating projects of international cooperation with partners.

Who can apply:

Any EU citizen over 18 years old willing to volunteer and get a unique experience among Ukrainian children and foster dialogue between the EU and Ukraine.

The knowledge of one or several EU languages (in addition to the mother tongue) is highly recommended.

The knowledge of Ukrainian and/or Russian is an asset.



Has relevant experience of working with children and has a creative approach to teaching / sharing experience and knowledge.

People with experience and/or academic expertise in the following fields are especially encouraged to apply: education, NGOs and social projects, special needs children and inclusion, media and communications, ecology and sustainable development.

Fill out the online application form and attach the requested documents according to the list.

- Scan of the passport valid at least till December 2020
- CV
- Suggestions and activities ideas on one of the mentioned topics: tolerance & inclusion or ecology & sustainable development
- Recommendations if available

The shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by Skype and their language skills may be assessed.
