



Open call for an Education Officer

We are looking for a proficient and passionate part-time Education Officer to advance the <u>Digital Labs: educators</u> from September 2021 until March 2023. We expect you to dedicate to the task 30 hours per week.

Digital Labs: educators are mini hackathons for everyone involved in changing the educational sphere in Ukraine for the better. For participants, those are 9 days, 15 workshops with experts, 5 hours of personal mentoring sessions, and one solution to the hot-button challenge per team. For you: an opportunity to manage a challenging project, expand your professional network with pros from abroad, and back the educational reform in Ukraine.

If you are interested in a full-time job, there is an option to take over Alumni community management in addition to Education Officer tasks.

House of Europe

House of Europe is a EU-funded programme fostering professional and creative exchange between Ukrainians and their colleagues in EU*1 countries. The programme focuses on culture and creative industries, education, health, social entrepreneurship, media, and youth.

This encompasses 20+ separate programme lines enabling us to go for conferences, professional events, internships, and networking in the EU*, or to enrol in study tours, residencies, training, and other forms of support. House of Europe funds cultural coproductions and cooperations between Ukrainian and EU* organisations, along with the development of cultural

infrastructure and artistic concepts for youth in Ukraine. Finally, the programme offers various youth camps and an intra-Ukrainian university exchange.

Implementation of House of Europe is led by <u>Goethe-Institut Ukraine</u>, with the British Council, Institut français, and Czech Centres as consortium partners. This vacancy is offered by the Goethe-Institut Ukraine, the official cultural institute of the Federal Republic of Germany and a leading international cultural organisation.

What you will be doing

- Managing <u>Digital Labs: educators</u>, ensuring they are delivered on time and to budget. Once travelling abroad is possible again, you may switch to in-person <u>Study Tours</u> to the EU*
- Reaching out to and collaborating with experts, organisations, and professional networks from Ukraine and the EU to design engaging programmes of the Digital Labs: educators
- Managing open calls for participants and selection criteria
- Collecting statistical information and feedback from participants of the Digital Labs: educators to adjust the programme to the audience's needs
- Managing operational finances, financial planning, timeliness of payments, and reporting for the activities
- Subcontracting experts and partners in compliance with administrative rules: tenders and procurements, documentation of spendings
- Taking care of the related paperwork

What skills and qualifications do you need

- English and Ukrainian to C1 level
- University degree in pedagogics, teaching, or social science
- At least two years' experience in project management
- Experience and network in the educational sector
- Ability to successfully work in a team
- Self-reflection and acceptance of criticism
- Structured and result-oriented approach
- Availability to work under stress and with temporarily high workload
- Readiness to travel for business and work on weekends and in the evenings when needed

- Experience in conceptualising educational programmes
- Experience in designing online events, especially for educators
- Experience in civil engagement, reform processes, change management
- Experience in managing international exchange
- Experience in working for donor-funded projects
