A team of experts will select successful applications according to the following criteria.

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| 1. | Motivation | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Is the applicant motivated to work on solutions for key topics of the programme? |
| 2. | Networking | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Does the applicant demonstrate interest in working in collaboration with peers on finding new solutions to foster the development, scaling and internationalisation of the business? |
| 3. | Profile of the social enterprise | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For how long has the applicant's social enterprise been operating on the market? Has it been operating for at least six months? Does the applicant's social enterprise have a clearly defined product or service? Is that already on the market or is it being tested? Has the social enterprise been affected by the pandemic? Is it in a state of stagnation? |

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| 4. | Role of the applicant in the social enterprise | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Does the applicant's role in the team allow him/her to implement new business and team solutions? ▪ Is the applicant a founder, co-founder or manager of the social enterprise? |
| 5. | Availability | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Will the applicant be able to attend all of the programme's online sessions? |
| 6. | Additional criteria | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Does the applicant know English at an upper intermediate or higher level? |
